The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, Manhattan-Elwood Public Library District was called to order at 4:31 pm.

Serving Our Public: Secretary Mason reviewed and discussed Chapters 3 (Personnel) and 4 (Access). Treasurer English will review Chapters 5 and 6 for the July meeting.

Presentation of 2022-2023 Tentative Budget: Trustee Blatti motioned and Treasurer English seconded the motion to approve the 2022-2023 Tentative Budget as finalized by the Budget committee. Motion passed unanimously with a roll call vote.

Operations & Hours Update: Discussed possibility of opening for more hours with the numbers of visitors still being well below normal. Vice President Braam motioned and Trustee Smeets seconded the motion to open the library to the public on Mondays, from 12-5pm, starting Monday, July 12. Motioned passed unanimously with a roll call vote.
